  - Monitoring and evaluation of treatment programs



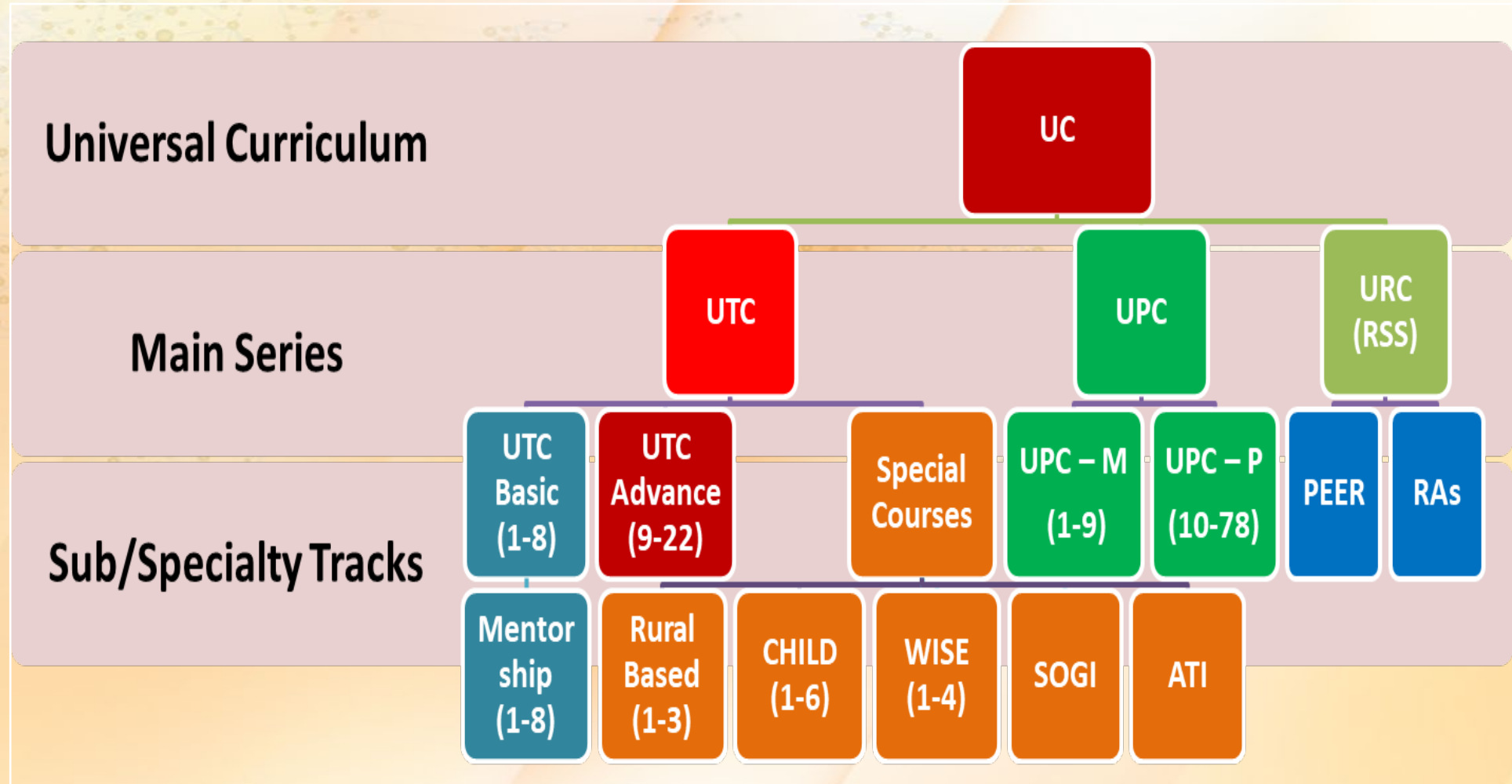

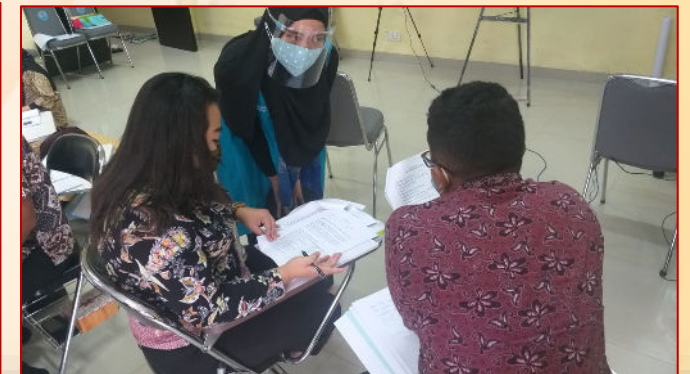
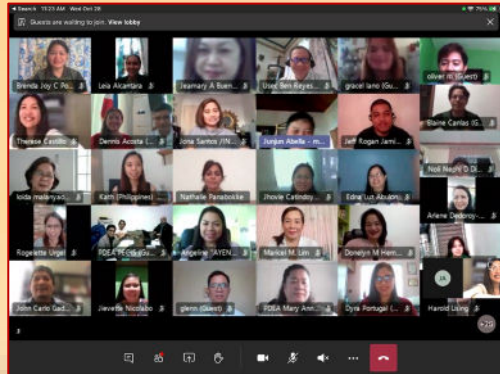

# TRAININGS ON UNIVERSAL CURRICULA

Along with the outbreak of covid-19 pandemic, DAP has transformed its' activities including UC trainings from physical settings to virtual platforms. Our online transformation includes virtual trainings, trainer-led and self-led courses.



## UNIVERSAL CURRICULA



### Virtual Trainings

Since the outbreak of the Pandemic in early 2020, DAP has nearly trained 580 individuals from its' Asian Members on the Universal Curricula through;

- 24 National V-Trainings,
- 3 Regional V- Trainings, &
- 5 V-Pilots



### Instructor-led courses

Most of the UTC and UPC courses which are being piloted online will be converted to instructor-led within the next 2 years. The instructor-led courses will be available on a set schedule with some synchronous sessions with a trainer.

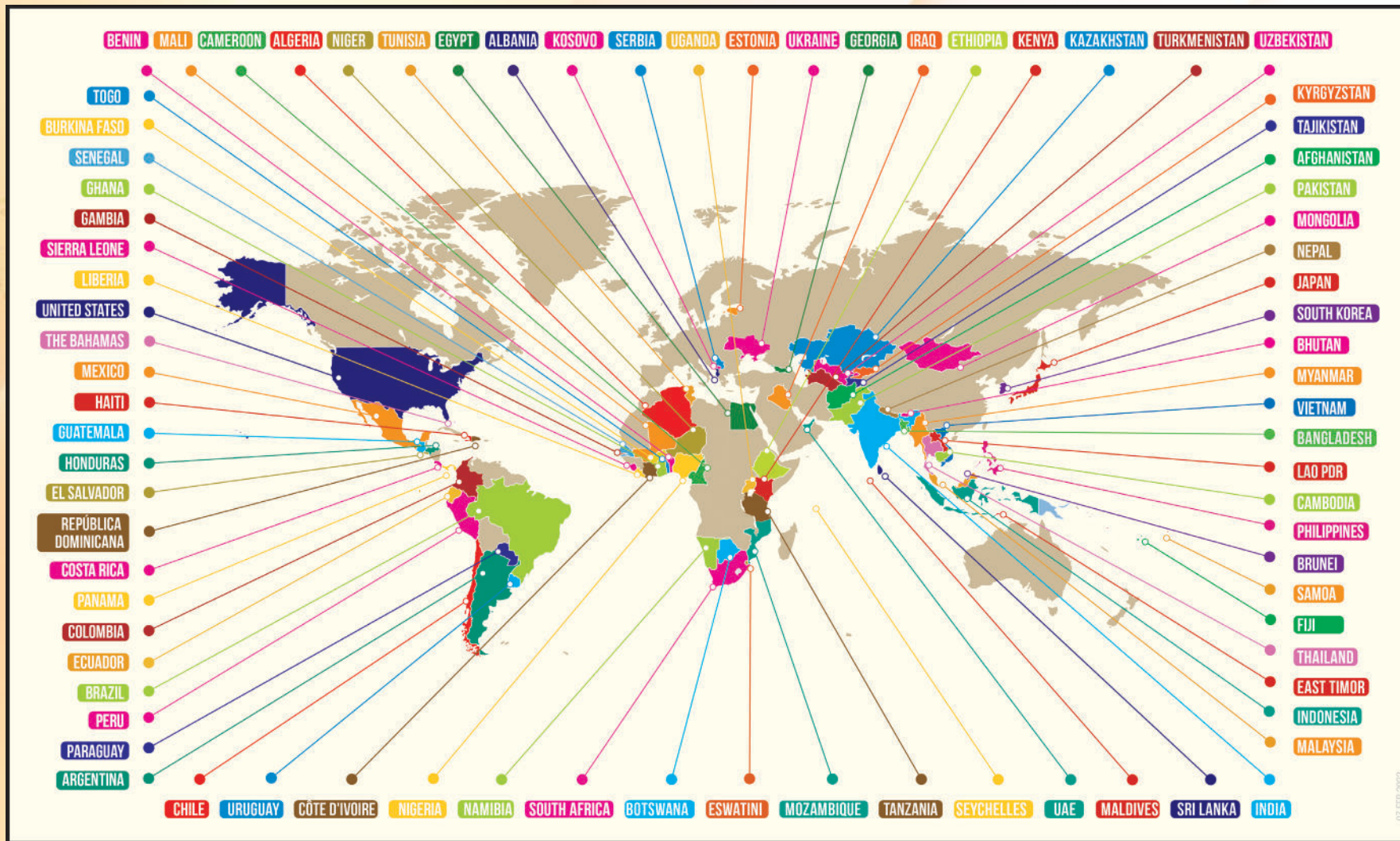


### Self-led courses
